

## APPLICATION FILING DEADLINES\*

[UCJA Rule 15-707. Application: deadlines, withdrawals, postponements, and fees.](#)

### **MARCH EXAMINATION:**

Application filing deadline date – October 1

Late Application filing deadline date – October 15 (include a \$50 late fee)

Final Application late filing deadline date – November 1 (include a \$100 late fee)

### **AUGUST EXAMINATION:**

Application filing deadline date – April 1

Late Application filing deadline date – April 15 (include a \$50 late fee)

Final Application late filing deadline date – May 1 (include a \$100 late fee)

The Application, with all forms and applicable supplementary documentation, must be **received** by the Bar (NOT postmarked) by close of business on the appropriate filing deadline.

If the deadline date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, then the deadline date will be the first business day thereafter.

Please note: NO applications or supplemental documentation for application will be accepted after November 1 for the March LPP exam and May 1 for the August LPP Exam.

## APPLICATION FEES

Application fees are subject to change without notice and are as follows:

- Ethics/Professional Responsibility Exam: \$100.
- Family Law Exam: \$100.
- Landlord/Tenant Exam: \$100.
- Debt Collection Exam: \$100.
  
- Late Fee: \$50 (applications filed between April 2 – April 15 for the August exam, or between October 2 – October 15 for the March exam).
- Final Late Fee: \$100 (applications filed between April 16 – May 1 for the August exam, or between October 16 – November 1 for the March exam).
  
- \*Incomplete Application Fee varies and may be up to \$150.

\*If at any time while processing your application the Bar discovers that your application is missing documentation that should have been included when you filed your application, you may be subject to late fees. This applies to ALL applications.

Application must be paid by credit card (no processing fee). Fill out **Utah State Bar LPP Application Payment Form** and submit it with the Application. **Please note that the Utah State Bar does not accept checks or money orders.**
